



Fox Hill 12 Hole Disc Golf Course

Fox Hill West Disc Golf Course Description

Fox Hill West Disc Golf Park is a 12 hole course that has a very open layout for beginners, with a few difficult shots along the creek for more advanced players. The course plays in a counterclockwise pattern featuring different elevation changes with seasonal wet areas for added challenges. You will find the first tee just down the trail from the practice hole. The course has grown in with foliage through the years, making shots from some tee boxes blind to the basket.

Hole 1: 141 feet straight throw out from the tee. There are sparse trees around basket.

Hole 2: 294 feet slightly to the left of the tee. There is temporary water hazard to the right.

Hole 3: 230 feet with dog leg to the right over the creek. It's heavily wooded around basket.

Hole 4: 242 feet straight between two trees over the creek. There is a temporary water hazard in front of the basket and sparse trees around the basket.

Hole 5: 327 feet slightly to the right of tee next to the woods. There is temporary water hazard to the left of the basket.

Hole 6: 282 feet slight dog leg left. The tee box is blind to the basket, elevation change in front of the basket, temporary water hazard near the far left, and sparse trees around basket.

Hole 7: 302 feet straight shot to the creek's edge with high grass in front of basket.

Hole 8: 207 feet straight out from the tee and is heavily wooded.

Hole 9: 275 feet straight out from the tee and wooded on the left side of the basket with temporary water hazard on the right.

Hole 10: 241 feet straight out from the tee with elevation change in front of the basket and sparse trees around basket.

Hole 11: 313 feet straight throw out from the tee with sparse trees around the basket.

Hole 12: 454 feet long straight out from the tee with sparse trees around the basket.

There is ample parallel parking along John Street.
